1. QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

1. Q - Please confirm the date for the pre-proposal meeting for the RFP for A/E Services for the SLC Mosquito Abatement District.

A – The pre-proposal meeting will be on April 6th. Pre-proposal meeting will be after the SOQ submission for short-listed firms only. All short-listed firms will be informed of the time for the pre-proposal meeting.

2. Q - Would you please send me a copy of the Project Overview Document referred to on page 1 of the RFQ?

A - The 'Project Overview and Guidelines' will be distributed to the shortlisted firms who attend the pre-proposal meeting on April 6th.

3. Q - We are hoping to get a copy of the Project Overview Document produced by MOCA Systems but are unable to find it on the SciQuest web page for this procurement. The RFP notes that the document will be provided as an attachment.

A - Thanks for your question regarding this RFQ. The 'Project Overview and Guidelines' will be distributed to the shortlisted firms who attend the pre-proposal meeting on April 6th. For now, we are looking for SOQ based on the RFQ's introduction and scope of work.

4. Q - I am wondering if this project is needing survey services or if that work has been

completed already for the proposed 7-acre site?

A – There is an ALTA survey that was completed on the site prior to the construction on the administrative project Nov. 2016. That survey can be provided to the selected AOR. If a new survey is required, the owner will provide.

2. CHANGES

1. Change to RFQ/RFP schedule. Date for ‘notification of intent to award’ has been moved from May 8th, 2023, to a new date of **May 26th, 2023**.
